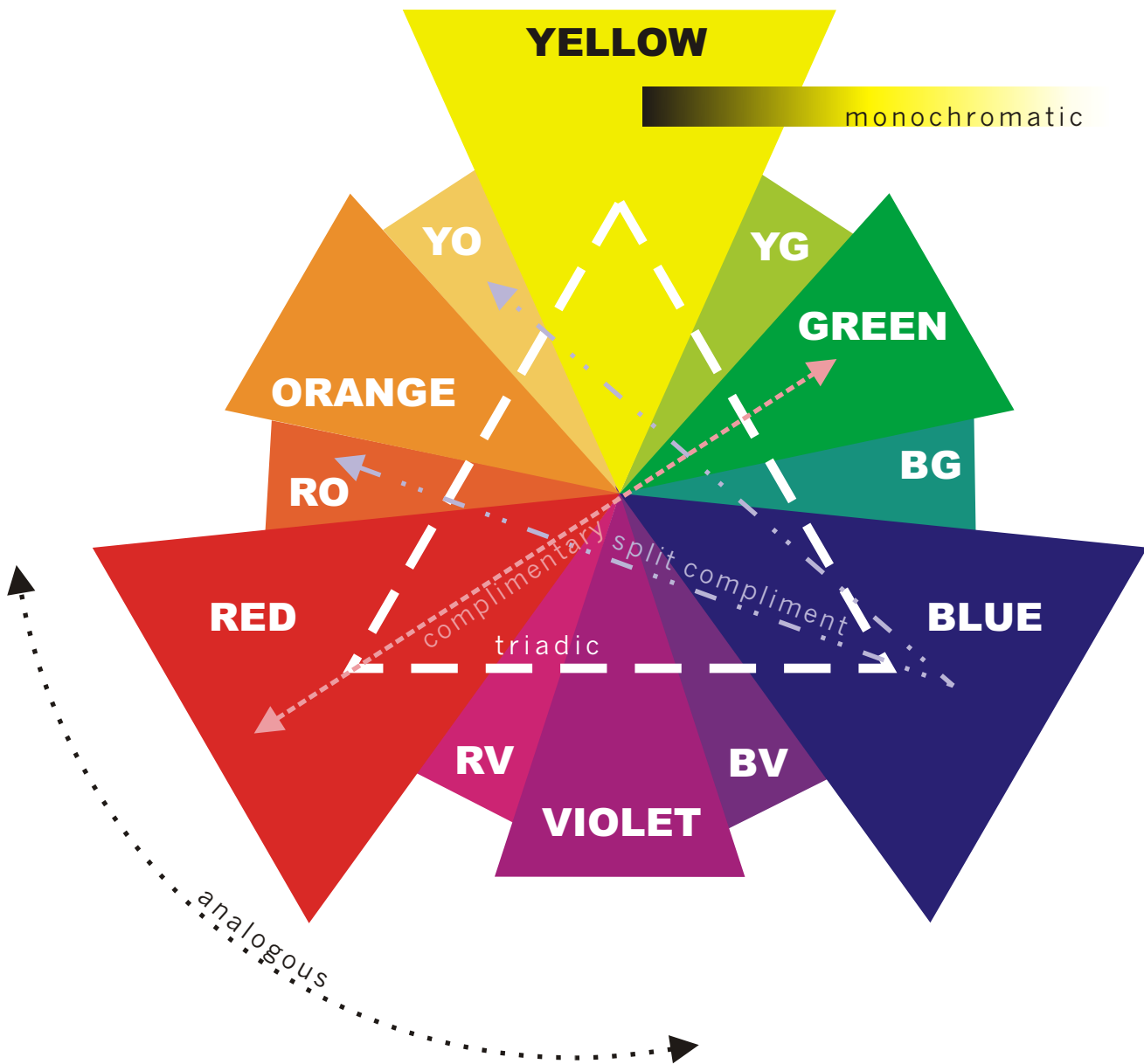


Common Color Combinations



Complimentary colors are opposites – they are located across the wheel from each other.

Triadic colors make a perfect triangle. The most popular triadic color schemes are the primary scheme (red, yellow, blue) and the secondary scheme (green, orange, violet).

Analogous colors are all on a row; on the arc of the wheel.

Split compliments involve one color and the colors on either side of its compliment.

Monochromatic colors are several shades of one color, like a black-and-white photo or a sepia-toned photo.
